Day 1: Fly out of Minneapolis.

Day 2: Welcome to Paris. We'll get together at our hotel after arrival. Lace up your walking shoes, as we explore our neighborhood, and start on our Heart of Paris walk, with Notre Dame, Ile de la Cite, l'Hotel de ville, the Pompidou Center, La Conciergerie, and Ste Chapelle if you wish.

Day 3: Louvre-Arc de Triomphe axis. We'll spend the morning at the Louvre, walk through the Tuileries gardens, through Place de la Concorde (site of the beheading during the French revolution), visit of the Petit Palais, then we'll continue all the way up to the Arc de Triomphe on the Champs Elysees. Free time on the Champs to shop, people watch at a café, savor a pastry...the choice is yours.

Day 4: Bastille Market, Orsay Museum, Sacre-Coeur Church & Montmartre. Start the day at a colorful market. Rub shoulders with the locals, taste treats, and observe how people shop for their daily meals. Visit of the Orsay Museum. Afternoon in Montmartre at Painters' Square and Sacre-Coeur Church.

Day 5: Versailles palace day trip. We will take the commuter train and head out to the palace of Versailles. This is your day to explore the palace of the Sun King, its gardens and Marie Antoinette's Hamlet. Eiffel Tower visit evening/night.

Day 6: Normandy excursion. Early morning departure to the D-day beaches with the American Cemetery, Omaha Beach, Pointe du Hoc. We will experience vivid accounts of WWII events with our local historian Christophe Rault. Late return.

Day 7: Free day in Paris to do as you please. If you prefer scheduled activities, we will offer to take you to the Opera Garnier, the Galeries Lafayette, and possibly the Catacombs if you are interested. How about closing the day with a cruise on the Seine river (Opt.)

Day 8: Tour over after breakfast. A bientot et merci! Feel free to extend your stay. It would be our pleasure to help you with your plans.
