- ❶ All tours have limited registration.
- ❷ Telephone registrations will only be accepted with a VISA or Mastercard payment.
- ❸ Registrations accepted at Community Education, or Senior Center in the Tilden Community Center, 310 River Street, Hastings.
- ❹ If cancellation is necessary, call **651-480-7689** as soon as possible. No refund will be made if tickets have been purchased, unless a substitute can be found. ***A \$5.00 processing fee applies to all cancellations.**
- ❺ No confirmation is given. If tour is cancelled/changed, you'll be notified.
- ❻ If you are added to a tour roster from a *Waiting List*, you **MUST pay the tour fee within 48 hours** or your name will be removed from the official roster.
